Confucius believed that these matters did not need to be searched anywhere, the ancestors had already done so. Consequently, Confucius devoted his physical and mental energy to researching the stories of the ancients to apply good and useful things as principles of personal and collective practice that would bring about the desired peace and prosperity of the world (Kotpoothron, K., and Chaithaweep, C. 2007: 12-13).

Confucius's ideas were very influential both in China and abroad. One of the most influential countries is Korea which has been colonized by many countries such as China, Japan and thus has expanded its cultural influence, beliefs, religions, and creeds. In which Korea, Confucius is popular and brings Confucius as a national morality. Korea has embraced the influence of Confucius instead of Buddhism, making Confucius play a huge role in the administration of the country and the way of life of the people of the Joseon era. It has become a daily practice of Korean people until now. Today, Confucius remains a cornerstone of Korea which has helped to form the moral, custom, way of life, social relations between adults and children, as well as high culture and form the basis of the legal system. Confucius in Korea is sometimes considered a practice of tying together nationhood without civil war or internal strife. These beliefs were passed down from the Goryeo dynasty (founded by the Goryeo dynasty in 918) to the Joseon dynasty state. Confucius in that dynasty quite remarkably flourished around the 16th century under the leadership of prominent intellectuals. The advancement of the Korean Confucius in the last 500 years of the Joseon dynasty state, much of which is explained by the fact that Korea fell under a lot of other countries and is also recorded in Korean history. Each play contains the basic principles of Confucius' ethics, the principle of mercy, the principle of righteousness, the principle of decency, the principle of

For the process of studying and analyzing data from documents or documentary research by reviewing the concepts, theories, and literature related to ethics Confucius in the Korean drama Dong Yi (great woman with thrones). Results

- 1.2 The ethical analysis inserted by the characters of each character or describes the content used to appear dharma only which uses a method to describe the behavior of the characters and bring up the principle as an explanation
- 2. The ethics that appear in the Korean drama Dong Yi (great woman, couple of thrones) found that
- The Principle of Mercy: In Chapter 4, it is the kindness that exists as a human being. generosity to others Help from what can help When others who have suffered without discrimination who are or who are inferior
- Principle of Righteousness: In Section 5, the fulfillment of one's own responsibilities by the righteous person appearing as a guardian is only responsible for adjudicating guilt from what is right and what is proven true.
- Principles of Appropriateness: Part 3 deals with considering the do's and don'ts of doing it, depending on the individual's habits as to whether what is done is right or not.
- Knowledge Principle: In Chapter 1, not shy about learning from others, even if one is a low-level person and a person of good character, sincerity, self-improvement, cultivating knowledge.
- Credibility Principle: Appears in the form of a character, from the character's position as a trustworthy person, others can be trusted and trusted depending on the person to have respectful behavior.
- 3. The five relationship principles that appear in the Korean drama Dong Yi (great woman, couple of thrones) were found;
- Rulers-Subordinates: In Chapter 10, the rulership must consider what is right, not taking personal matters as an exception in the judgment of wrongdoing, it will be considered unjust, rules will not be considered. rules anymore
- Parents-Children: In Chapter 5, disagreeing with a mother must use polite words, approach him politely, seeing that you do not follow your intentions must not hinder and continue to work hard. go
- Husband-Wife: Explained in a generalized form of the content of the series because according to the Korean belief that "men represent heaven". Therefore, in the relationship seen in this series, the husband must take care of his wife, must be responsible for the family, behave with integrity and the wife must obey.

- Brother-Sister: In episode 3, I have to act like an older brother, I have to take care of my younger sister, help me when I'm in trouble, help me willingly, even if I have to sacrifice my life to help my younger sister, the younger sister must obey me. Respecting the decision of the elders
- Friends-Friends: In Chapter 4, a mutually supportive relationship with a friend must choose a good relationship, building mutual respect must be a respectable person, having a sincere speech, not taking advantage of each other.

Discussion

An ethical research study of Confucius appeared in the Korean drama Dong Yi (great woman with the throne). From the point of study that gives rise to new knowledge in the study of ethics, seeing the teaching dimension in entertainment media is not the study of the scriptures but the study through the film series that we can create new perspectives. In an educational sense, not only the textbook boundaries lie in the content of the play, including the principle of mercy, the principle of righteousness, the principle of decency, the principle of knowledge, and the principle of trustworthiness. In addition, it was found that the relationship principles that the students studied appeared in this series, which found the relationship between individuals and society as follows: (1) parents and subordinates, (2) parents and children, (3) husband and wife, (4) brother and sister, and (5) friend and friend. The student who has studied the principles listed above can explain that the principles found are the ethical principles of Confucius that the individual adheres to and adheres to in social, economic, political, and governmental life. In a social context, as Confucius states, "Only one who is truly humane can love or hate others" (Mookpradit, M. 2004).

From the foregoing, it can be seen that Confucius had the ideology of creating equality in society from what is called "humanitarian", in which the development of members of society into a population of quality consists of knowledge and virtue. Confucius believed in the human potential to create a peaceful society on its own. The principles of Confucius's philosophical practice concerning various aspects of social order are the establishment of norms, the determination of status and roles, and the establishment of principles of socialization. The above study found that this research paper is similar to the work of Intadod, S. (2007) analyzing the role of women in the Dae series. Jang-geum (great woman of the palace) is based on feminist ideas. It made me realize that both works had a teaching dimension, Confucius, that appeared in Korean culture expressed through entertainment media.

Applying the research results recommendation

From the study and analysis of the ethics of Confucius in the K-drama Dong Yi (great woman with the throne) is a build on the ethical organization found in the play that can be developed in a new educational way, which from education. It appears that a lot of people are interested. But it was only Confucius' interest and study of ethics. However, in the study of the application of dharma to be analyzed in the play, there is very little. Therefore, the students would like to suggest that they study the ethics of Confucius, the Korean drama Dong Yi (great woman, couple of thrones) from the study only from episodes 1-10 to study the whole story of this series.
